

PBBA Team Competition

- 1) The cost for a PBBA team is \$2,000 per team
 - a) \$1,000 paid with Team application and the balance paid over 60-days, or before the any of the team bulls compete in his fourth team event, whichever comes first.
- 2) A team consists of three bulls
 - a) When created each team must identify at least one bull in Tier I or Tier II. For example, one Tier I & two Tier II bulls.
 - b) If one or all Tier II bulls on a Team move up to Tier I because of PBBA money won, it's ok as long as they started in Tier II when the Team was created.
 - c) One alternate bull can be named when creating the team and he can buck for any bull on the Team under the PBBA completion rules.
 - d) The 3 nominated bulls and the one alternate bull listed on the Team application cannot not be replaced or substituted with any other bull(s) for any reason whatsoever.
 - e) Team members do not have to own the bulls. They can work out a private arrangement will any bull owner or owners.
 - f) A bull can only be on one team.
 - g) Bulls must be eligible to compete in PBBA events according to the PBBA rules. PBBA competition rules apply to all PBBA Team bulls and Teams.
 - h) Each of the three bulls on the PBBA Team must compete in 4 PBBA events during the Team season. A total of 12 outs for the Team.
 - i) If the alternate bull is used the Team Captain must state when calling in the PBBA entries that the Team alternate is being used in place of a Team bull and he must name the Team bull that the alternate is bucking for. The alternate's PBBA Team out and score with then count for the bull he replaced for that event.
 - j) The alternate can "fill in" for any one of the three bulls on the Team at anytime.
 - k) Once a Team bull has had is 4 PBBA Team outs, no further PBBA events will count toward his Team points.

PBBA Team Competition

- l) When entering a bull in a PBBA event the Team Captain must state the bull is competing for the team.
 - m) All Team bulls do not have to be entered in the same event. For example, bring one Team bull at a time, bring two or bring three. As long as all three compete in 4 events throughout the season.
- 3) Team Point System
- i) Money won does not count toward Team points.
 - ii) If the bull places in the top 50% (rounded up for odd entry events) of the final results for the PBBA tier entered; multiply the total score by 50% (100% for a one performance event). If a bull places in the bottom 50% (rounded down for odd entry events) multiply the total score by 45% (90% for a one performance event).
 - iii) Each Team bull gets a bonus point for each second or fraction thereof rode during a qualified ride. For example; a 3.77 second ride is an extra 3.77 points.
 - (1) A disqualification by the bull rider for slapping & etc. The ride is over when judge stops the watch. For example, when the bull is slapped.
 - (2) A PBBA re-buck is a second ride & the time from the re-buck is used.
- 4) Team payout will depend on the number of teams.
- i) PBBA Teams will payback 90% of the Team fees at the end of the Team season.
 - ii) 10-14 teams pays 4 holes, 15-19 teams pays 5 holes, 20 -30 teams pays 6 holes
 - iii) Maximum number of teams is 30
- 5) PBBA Team Rules are subject to change upon approval by the PBBA Board & following discussion with all Team Captains.
