

Professional Bucking Bull Association, LLC  
Event Producers Agreement

This agreement dated \_\_\_\_\_ between the Professional Bucking Bull Association, LLC, (PBBA) a South Carolina Limited Liability Company and \_\_\_\_\_ (Producer) a \_\_\_\_\_.

Whereas Producer agrees to produce an Open Bucking Bull Competition sanctioned by the PBBA and the PBBA agrees to sanction the Open Bucking Bull Competition, this agreement documents the terms of the PBBA sanctioning and the rules the Producers agree to be bound by.

A. Producer agrees to the following:

1. Agrees to follow the payout schedule & rules listed in the PBBA Rules.
2. If the Producer has added money the money is funded by the either producer or sponsorships. It is added to the total money available to be paid out to the owners of the winning bulls and is paid out according to the PBBA payout schedule.
3. The event must be sanctioned by an accredited bull riding association or is a "Bring Your Own Rider Event."
4. The Producer will receive fifty dollars (\$50.00) per bull entered through the PBBA office, paid from the PBBA entry fees.
5. Producer will produce the event in accordance to the Competition Format in the PBBA Rules.
6. Producer understands that they are responsible for providing sufficient and safe pens to house all of the PBBA bulls and realizes that separate pens may be required for each bull. The flooring of the pens must be safe and harmless to the bulls' feet.
7. Producer agrees to provide the necessary back pen help to move the bulls during the event.
8. Producer agrees to provide the PBBA contractors access to water.
9. Producer agrees to supply the venue to buck the PBBA bulls, including at least two (2) left hand delivery and two (2) right hand delivery bucking chutes. These chutes must be in good operating condition and safe for bucking the bulls.
10. Producer understands that he is responsible for paying two (2) of the judges; the two he pays will be the two (2) judges that judge both the bulls and the bull riders.
11. As the event producer the Producer is to provide and pay the announcer, bull fighters, bull rider secretary, back pen help, latch man, gate man and any other help needed to produce a bull riding.
12. As the event producer, the Producer receives all of the gate and ticket money and does not share it with the PBBA.
13. Producer understands that the PBBA judges must be assigned to the event by the PBBA Director of Judges or approved by the Director of Judges prior to the event.

14. This agreement must be signed and received in the PBBA office no later than forty five (45) prior to the event.
15. Producer agrees that they are not entitled to the Producer's fees in number A(4) above if the event is canceled for any reason by the Producer or canceled by the PBBA for noncompliance with the PBBA rules or this agreement.

B. PBBA agrees to the following:

1. Advertise the event in all PBBA advertising and on the PBBA website.
2. Open the entries for the event three weeks prior to the event and close them one week prior to the event.
3. Receive all bull entries which will be sent to the PBBA.
4. Once the entries are closed notify the Producer of the number of entries received and paid.
5. To pay four (4) or three (3) of the PBBA judges, depending on the judging format used.
6. Provide the PBBA hip numbers and assist in tagging the PBBA bulls.
7. Provide a PBBA representative at the event to tally the PBBA judges' scores and pay the winnings, pay the judges in number 5 above, and to pay the Producer the Producer's fee.

This agreement is binding on both parties and will be interpreted under the laws of South Carolina. By signing the event Producer agrees to the term and conditions of this agreement and confirms they have received and read a copy of the PBBA rules.
